

Rules to be Applied within the scope of COVID 19 in the 2021-2022 Education Period

- In order to minimize the risk caused by the Covid-19 pandemic in terms of public health and public order, the basic principles of the fight against the pandemic, which includes the rules of cleaning, mask and distance will be followed.
- HES codes of all students and academic and administrative staff will be checked at the campus entrances of our university, those with PCR positive or risks will not be allowed in the campuses.
- Necessary hygienic operations will be carried out continuously in classrooms, social environments and other facilities on campuses. Disinfection processes will be done on all campuses on weekends.
- The fever of all students and academic and administrative staff will be checked with thermometer systems at the campus entrances of our university, and those with high fever will not be allowed in the campuses and will be directed to healthcare institutions.
- Students, Academic and Administrative staff will be advised that vaccination is necessary along with the awareness that the most effective element in the fight against the pandemic is the vaccination activities carried out.
- Our academic and administrative staff, who have not been vaccinated or have had their first vaccination, or 14 days have not passed since they had their second vaccination, will have a PCR Test every Monday and will report the result to the Infirmary of the University.
- Students who are detected with the findings such as fever and/or upper respiratory tract infection in the university will be going or sent to the infirmary and will be directed to a healthcare institution for PCR testing after the first evaluation.
- Students who had PCR test will transmit their PCR test results to the Infirmary of the University.
- As long as they are documented, students who have a report of Covid-19 positive and those who are included in the risk group, **will not be considered absent** from their classes for 14 days.
- If and to the extent of a second positive case within 10 days in the same class, students who are taking that course will be placed into quarantine for 14 days and this period of time will not be counted as absenteeism.
- In case PCR test results of the academic staff who lectures are positive, if the academic staff is able to teach, he or she will be teaching the course online, and if they are unable to teach, made up courses for the missing courses will be done after the illness.
- If the illness of the academic staff exceeds 14 days, a new academician will be appointed for the continuation of the course.
